Since the “Model Railways for a Day” Convention at Zillmere in October, the MRQC committee has met on two occasions to consider holding an MRQC in 2018. We are please to advice that we have good news. The Beenleigh Events Centre has been booked for Saturday 13 October 2018. We have access from 08:00 giving us a start time of 09:00. It’s early days, we are looking at a program similar to the 2012 convention. The main hall is a little smaller than the bowls club we used in 2016, but the second room for presentations is larger and is indoors, the centre is fully air conditioned. The centre is a short walk from the Railway Station and Beenleigh Transit Centre.
